Pricing Calculator

How much money do you need to earn each month to replace your current income?
What is your current or projected hourly rate?
How much are you spending (or are planning to spend) on software?
Any other expenses?
Examples:
$30/hour \times 4 hours work + 1 hour admin time + 1/4 software cost = $200.00 per blog post$
$30/hour \times 8 hours work + 1 hour admin time + 1/4 software cost = $320.00 per blog post$
NOTE: I'm not suggesting charging by the hour - but it's good to keep in mind what you want to be compensated for your time when you're creating your packages.

Packages

List out everything included with your offers. These will be the bullet points that make it crystal clear exactly what is included (and not included) in your offer.

- Market, content, and keyword research
- 1,250 1,500 word blog post
- SEO optimized content
- Outbound links
- Delivered in fully editable Google document
- 2 round of edits
- Meta description
- 3 social media graphics with captions
- Promotional email copy
- Blog images
- Upload to Wordpress or Square Space
- Schedule blog to go live
- 20 minute strategy call
- Limit 4 per month
